PENTECOST

8th June 2025

Pentecost which means "fiftieth" was one of the annual feasts in the Jewish calendar. It was primarily a feast of thanksgiving for the harvest, the first fruits of the wheat crop. Later on the giving of the Law to Moses on Mount Sinai was commemorated on this day. All Jews, not impeded by the law were expected to go to Jerusalem to the Temple for the feast and Jerusalem would be full to overflowing. It was fitting that this feast was chosen for the Descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles. It is celebrated fifty days after Easter, commemorating when the Apostles gathered together in Jerusalem as they were told by the Lord (Lk 24:49) until the Holy Spirit came on them. The Holy Spirit made his presence felt by the noise of a strong driving wind. Each foreigner who spoke the language of the country he came from heard one or other of the Apostles speaking his language. The Holy Spirit brings understanding among people and fosters unity in diversity.

Pentecost is also called the "birthday" of the Church when the mission of Christ was open to the whole world through the Apostles. They were backed by the divine power of the Holy Spirit. Frail and mortal human beings are made spiritual heroes by the power of the Holy Spirit. The work of the Holy Spirit is seen in the Church's ministry today. The voice of the Holy Spirit is still as strong as it was on that first Pentecost. His powers are divine and will never diminish. We pray today, "come Holy Spirit, enkindle in the hearts of the faithful the fire of divine love."



PENTECOST SUNDAY - YR C

First reading Acts 2:1-11 They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak

When Pentecost day came round, they had all met in one room, when suddenly they heard what sounded like a powerful wind from heaven, the noise of which filled the entire house in which they were sitting; and something appeared to them that seemed like tongues of fire; these separated and came to rest on the head of each of them. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and began to speak foreign languages as the Spirit gave them the gift of speech.

Now there were devout men living in Jerusalem from every nation under heaven, and at this sound they all assembled, each one bewildered to hear these men speaking his own language. They were amazed and astonished. 'Surely' they said 'all these men speaking are Galileans? How does it happen that each of us hears them in his own native language? Parthians, Medes and Elamites; people from Mesopotamia, Judaea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya round Cyrene; as well as visitors from Rome – Jews and proselytes alike – Cretans and Arabs; we hear them preaching in our own language about the marvels of God.'

Second reading Romans 8:8-17

Everyone moved by the Spirit is a son of God

People who are interested only in unspiritual things can never be pleasing to God. Your interests, however, are not in the unspiritual, but in the spiritual, since the Spirit of God has made his home in you. In fact, unless you possessed the Spirit of Christ you would not belong to him. Though your body may be dead it is because of sin, but if Christ is in you then your spirit is life itself because you have been justified; and if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, then he who raised Jesus from the dead will give life to your own mortal bodies through his Spirit living in you.

So then, my brothers, there is no necessity for us to obey our unspiritual selves or to live unspiritual lives. If you do live in that way, you are doomed to die; but if by the Spirit you put an end to the misdeeds of the body you will live.

Everyone moved by the Spirit is a son of God. The spirit you received is not the spirit of slaves bringing fear into your lives again; it is the spirit of sons, and it makes us cry out, 'Abba, Father!' The Spirit himself and our spirit bear united witness that we are children of God. And if we are children we are heirs as well: heirs of God and coheirs with Christ, sharing his sufferings so as to share his glory.
